

Welcome to our July Newsletter,

A bit closer to home there is much discussion in WA regarding the disruption to supply chains due to ongoing congestion in Singapore and the potential shortages that may follow.

Amid those challenges and as we welcome relief to many of our clients, it is pleasing that space availability and rates for both coastal shipping and rail from east to west

remain stable as we move into Q3 and with peak season fast approaching.

We would welcome any opportunities to quote on existing and potential projects and one-off shipments for the imminent peak season rush.

The rail has recently announced a focus on addressing inconsistencies in truck and trailer weights for equipment entering their terminals, advising that as many as 20% of vehicles are incorrectly declared which causes problems in the train loading process that can affect safety, as well as a frustrating discrepancy in the chargeable weight to shippers.

We recommend that all our clients discuss this with their chosen carriers. If we can assist with further information, please don't hesitate to get in touch with any of our team members.

For those looking to ship cargo to Tasmania we're excited by a newly formed relationship that facilitates regular supply of containers from all mainland locations into the Apple Isle.

This is particularly pleasing in the case of 40' containers, which have always been difficult to secure on this route.
